- 7. In 1951, Eugene Smith spent 6 weeks following a midwife in South Carolina. What was the significance of that photo essay? What was important about it during that era?
- 8. Why did Smith threaten to abandon the Schweitzer project?
- 9. Why did Smith resign from Life Magazine. Do you feel he was justified in doing this?
- 10. Smith was described as being a perfectionist, an artist, and a poet. Ask the students if they would agree with that statement. Make a new IWB board titled: "Eugene Smith" and give examples to support on opinions.
